When Mount Moriah has the personnel and resources to accomplish its mission of *leading people to Jesus and transforming believers into His likeness*. We see Mount Moriah Church with hundreds of called, trained, competent volunteers and staff executing the church's strategy. (Matthew 28:19-20)

We See A Day . . .

When Mount Moriah has a quality Christian Counseling Center to address the underlying spiritual and psychological issues which plague our communities. When both licensed and trained lay counselors volunteer to provide biblical guidance to persons experiencing distress because of disruptive events and relationships. We see people experiencing wholeness and becoming healthy spiritually, socially, and psychologically. (2 Corinthians 1:1-7)

We See A Day . . .

When Mount Moriah has a ministry care center on its

campus called *The Potter's House* - a center which houses several of the church's ministries to members and community constituents in need of temporary assistance. This spiritual house of restoration will become one of the church's means of meeting the immediate felt needs of people; however our ultimate goal is ministering to their spiritual needs. (Matthew 25:31-46)

We See A Day . . .

When Mount Moriah has an effective discipleship strategy and structure for making more mature disciples. We envision a process that starts with people who are not Christians and systematically develops them along a spiritual continuum that culminates in their maturing into the likeness of Christ. This structure will facilitate discipling large numbers of

believers, developing mature leaders, encouraging spiritual formation, and providing pastoral care for every church member. (Matthew 28:19-20; Ephesians 4:11-16)

We See A Day . . .

When Mount Moriah has an international evangelistic and missions strategy that equips members to use contemporary and creative means to share the gospel without fear. We will provide multiple opportunities for members to use contemporary means of communicating God's love to unbelievers. We see members practicing life-style evangelism, witnessing, drama, evangelistic crusades, prayer walks, and church planting. We will undergird help ministries with evangelism. (Mark 16:15; Acts 1:8; 1 Corinthians 9:21-22)

We See A Day . . .

When Mount Moriah is sharing the love of Christ through our service as missionaries in Africa, Jamaica, Haiti, and other remote parts of the world often disenfranchised from the missionary efforts of other agencies. We will establish strategic partnerships that can sustain our efforts of making disciples around the world. We are leading teams on short-term mission trips to spread the gospel, provide medical assistance, and strengthen indigenous ministries. (Matthew 28:19-20; Mark 16:15)

We See A Day . . .

When Mount Moriah's Youth and Children's ministries provide a corresponding discipleship strategy, structure, and opportunities for developing spiritually mature young men and women of God. We will use effective, contemporary and diverse resources as a means of facilitating spiritual transformation that starts at one's current level of growth and

systematically moves them to the next phase of maturity in their progression to Christ-likeness. (Luke 2:52; Ephesians 4:11-16)

We See A Day . . .

Mount Moriah has a contemporary worship and arts facility which accommodates its ability to convey God's message to believers and unbelievers using various expressions of worship and communication (praise, drama, music, symphony, plays, etc.). The sanctuary seating and construction will accommodate thousands of worshippers expressing their adoration to Christ and hearing the Word of God. We envision a unique structure that enables the church to establish a safe territory for interfacing with the un-churched. (Psalm 67:3-5; John 4:23-24)

We See A Day . . .

When Mount Moriah has a regionally accredited Christian & Performing Arts Academy spanning preschool through elementary. This Academy will establish a solid foundation for Christian development, spiritual and academic excellence, and also introduce students to the joys of music and arts. We see children meeting the challenge of academic rigor and the formation of a Judeo-Christian worldview, and hundreds of children succeeding in middle school and beyond . . . (Proverbs 22:6; 2 Timothy 3:14-16)

When Mount Moriah has a Christian Leadership Development Center for the study of servant leadership. We see current and emerging leaders receiving quality leadership training for service in the church, the community and businesses around the world. We envision mature members responding to God's call to start ministries that facilitate the transformation of others into His likeness. (Ephesians 4:11-12; 2 Timothy 2:2)
